This position oversees a growing campus ministry that focuses upon spirituality, nurture, worship, and mission. The inter-denominational Chaplain will provide opportunities for personal Christian growth of members of the University Community through worship, counseling, workshops, and programming events. The University College Chaplaincy shall be responsible for the spiritual and moral growth and development of the University College.

The Person

- 1. Must be a committed evangelical Christian with good spiritual and moral track record.
- 2. Must possess a minimum of Master of Divinity/MPhil / MA (Theology) degree or equivalent from an accredited seminary or university. Life experience will be considered.
- 3. Being an ordained Minister with strong pastoral training and a theological background would be an added advantage.
- 4. Must possess broad ecumenical and multi-faith perspectives.
- 5. Must be able to demonstrate significant experience working with individuals of diverse cultural, ethnic, and religious backgrounds.
- 6. A commitment to and history of mentoring students.
- 7. Must have a proven ability to provide spiritual leadership to University College Students.
- 8. Must possess counseling capabilities.
- 9. Must be ready to teach at least one course.

The Responsibilities

- i. Promote evangelism, discipleship and community worship on the campus
- ii. Promote effective prayer mobilization among both staff and students
- iii. Encourage the development of regular personal devotional life among staff and students.
- iv. Coordinate the provision of quality counseling services to members of the CSUC Community.
- v. Plan and organize regular worship services for the Regular, Evening and Weekend sessions of the University College; and
- vi. Undertake other routine functions of the Chaplaincy Unit including:
- vii. Selection and invitation of speakers and singing groups
- viii. Oversee the procurement, use and storage of musical instruments.
- ix. Monitor the activities of GHAFES
- x. Coordinate the Faith and Practice Programme
- xi. Play a key role in the hiring of new staff and the promotion of staff of the University College.
