CSUC Awards Full Scholarships to St. Monica's Debate Winners

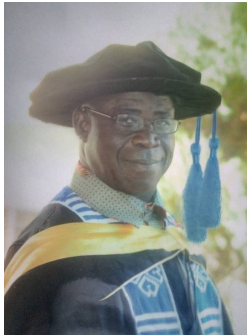
