

Christian Service University Adjudged the Most Outstanding Private University



Christian Service University (CSU) has been adjudged the "Most Outstanding Private University in the Ashanti Region" at the 2025 edition of the Ashanti Business Merit Awards, a prestigious awards scheme recognizing excellence across corporate and institutional sectors.

The award was conferred at a high-profile gala held at the Lancaster Hotel in Kumasi, on 18th July, 2025. The event brought together distinguished guests from Ghana's business community, senior government officials, chiefs, civil society leaders, and the media.

Criteria for Selection

Christian Service University's recognition follows a rigorous selection process that included in-depth research, thorough assessment, and validation by a dedicated team of research consultants and a specially constituted Awards Jury. The selection focused on performance within the past year, as well as prior achievements that have meaningfully shaped CSU's current impact—culminating in the award of the Presidential Charter, a landmark testament to the University's academic and institutional excellence. This Charter marks a milestone and affirms CSU's status as a full-fledged, autonomous university of academic and institutional distinction.

Founded in 1974, Christian Service University has evolved through the decades -- from a Bible College, to a liberal arts university College -- into a vibrant, accredited university with a strong Christian ethos. Now in its 51st year, CSU continues to distinguish itself as a hub of academic excellence, ethical leadership, and transformational education.
