CHRISTIAN SERVICE UNIVERSITY LAUNCHES DOCTOR OF MINISTRY (DMIN) IN CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

Christian Service University, Kumasi (CSU) is pleased to announce the launch of its flagship programme, Doctor of Ministry (DMin) in Christian Leadership and Management, a distinctive programme designed to equip current and aspiring leaders with advanced theological, managerial, and leadership skills.

The programme is open to individuals holding a Master's degree from an accredited institution, including those in theology, divinity, religious studies, and other disciplines such as engineering, medicine, banking, education, and entrepreneurship. This inclusivity ensures a rich, multidisciplinary learning environment where participants integrate Christian principles with practical leadership in diverse contexts.

Key Features of the DMin Programme:

- **Duration:** 3 years
- **Mode:** Hybrid (in-person and online), with an option for fully online study
- **Program Structure:** One year of taught courses followed by two years dedicated to a thesis (40,000–50,000 words)
- **Course Load:** Six courses per semester, including core and electives
- **Assessment:** Continuous assessment (40%) and end-of-semester exams (60%); minimum CGPA of 2.0 required for progression
- **Admission Process and Sale of Admission Forms:** Applications open from 1st June – 15th July, 2026; application voucher costs GHS 300
- **Focus:** Christian leadership, ethical management, organizational influence, and practical ministry

Programme Schedule and Event Launch

The DMin programme is scheduled to commence in September 2026, with a launch ceremony at CSU, Kumasi on Monday, 1st June, 2026 at 10. a.m.

The event, to be attended by academics, government officials, church leaders, and stakeholders, will feature Most Rev. Prof. Emmanuel Asante, Chancellor of the University, and former Presiding Bishop of the Methodist Church, as Keynote Speaker, addressing the theme: “Bridging Scholarship and Practice: The Role of the Doctor of Ministry in Contemporary Church and Societal Leadership.”

CSU's DMin programme stands out for:

1. **World-Class Lecturers and Supervisors:** Guidance by experienced faculty combining academic rigor with ministry insight
2. **Flexible Hybrid Learning:** Balances academic study with professional or ministry commitments
